

NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED)

- 1. The field is hereby informed of the Press Release by the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) re: National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Postpones the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED). The reason of postponement is the declaration of September 21 as National Day of Protest by President Rodrigo R. Duterte. The new schedule for the conduct the above-mentioned activity is yet to be determined by the NDRRMC.
- 2. Furthermore, the activities on promoting family earthquake preparedness must still be implemented per Division Memorandum No. 478, s. 2017 re: Reiteration of DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2015 (Promoting Family Earthquake Preparedness) as Part of the Preparedness Measures for the 3rd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED).

#### NDRRMC POSTPONES 3RD QUARTER NATIONWIDE EQ DRILL

19 September 2017 - The National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) announces the postponement of the 3rd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED).

Early morning, the NDRRMC Chairperson and National Defense Secretary Delfin N Lorenzana has made a pronouncement to postpone the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter NSED originally scheduled on 21 September 2017, 2PM

PRRD has declared 21 September as a National Day of Protest and in effect has announced the suspension of classes and work in government offices. Since most of the Regional DRRM Councils have selected government offices and schools as its pilot area, the National Council deemed it necessary to conduct the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter NSED to a later date. This is to ensure maximum participation to the earthquake drill

The new schedule of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter NSED is yet to be determined. The NDRRMC conducts Nationwide Earthquake Drills quarterly, as one of the tools to promote disaster preparedness and resilience among communities
