

Rule 6, Section 7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the RA 10121 states that "Public awareness shall also be undertaken through the conduct of drills by the LDRRMO on a regular basis". Likewise, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) states that one of the activities to achieve Outcome 10: "Developed and implemented comprehensive national and local preparedness and response policies, plans and systems" is to develop/ enhance and simulate scenario-based preparedness and response plans. Furthermore, one of the policy framework stated in the National Disaster Preparedness Plan as embedded in the fourth priority area of the Sendai Framework for Action 2015 - 2030 includes the target: "to promote regular disaster preparedness, response and recovery exercises".

The CY 2017 3rd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) scheduled on 21 September 2017 has been postponed to 27 September 2017 at 2:00 P.M. The ceremonial venue shall be at Strike Gymnasium, Baccor, Cavite.

The objectives are as follows:

- 1. To test the efficiency and usefulness of the preparedness, response and recovery plans, systems and policies developed in their respective localities/ offices/ schools:
- To evaluate the effectiveness of contingency plan;
- 3. To test the coordination and communication mechanism during response operation.
- 4. To understand the command and control mechanism in emergency and disaster operation at the DRRMCs.

All NDRRMC member agencies and OCD Regional Offices are directed to conduct similar activities.

Proper documentation and the conduct of the Post Activity Evaluation is encouraged. Result of the analysis and documentation should be submitted to the Capacity Building and Training Service through electronic mail at chts@ocd.gov.ph not later than 05 October 2017 for consolidation and submission to the Chairperson, NORRMC.
