

Office's (CDRRMO) Text Message Stating that Bukidnon is Under TCWS

No. 2 For Tropical Storm Basyang

- 1. The field is hereby informed of the text message coming from the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) stating that **Bukidnon is under TCWS No. 2** for Tropical Storm Basyang. Hence, as stated in DepEd Order No. 43, s. 2012 re: Guidelines on the Implementation of Executive Order No. 66 (Prescribing Rules on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Government Offices Due to Typhoons, Flooding, Other Weather Disturbances, and Calamities), **all classes in preschool, kindergarten, elementary, and secondary** are suspended or cancelled until further notice.
- 2. Moreover, all are directed to keep on monitoring the weather updates issued by PAGASA
