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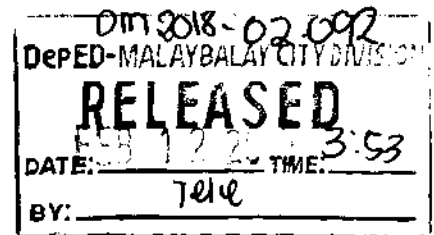

For information and guidance of all concerned, this Office hereby disseminates DepED Memorandum No. 017, s. 2018 dated February 6, 2018 entitled "2018 National Observance of Autism Consciousness Week" with the theme *From Awareness to Acceptance, Accommodation and Appreciation*. This is in pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 711 entitled Declaring the Third Week of January and Every Year Thereafter as National Autism Consciousness Week.

2018 NATIONAL OBSERVANCE OF AUTISM CONSCIOUSNESS WEEK

1. The 2018 National Autism Consciousness Week will be observed from January 14 to 20, 2018 for children and persons with autism with the theme From Awareness to Acceptance, Accommodation and Appreciation. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 711 entitled Declaring the Third Week of January and Every Year Thereafter as National Autism Consciousness Week.
2. The observance aims to develop awareness on the problems of persons with autism and promote a supportive environment that will enable them to live with dignity, function independently, and contribute productively to society.
3. All public, private and Special Education (SPED) Centers and schools with SPED programs for children and persons with autism are encouraged to undertake the following suggested activities:
 - a. Increase public awareness of children and persons with autism on the Inclusive Program under the prescribed K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum;
 - b. Media announcements, guestings, and press releases;
 - c. Issuance and circulation of Memorandum;
 - d. Serve as a vehicle of information on the continuing development of programs implemented to realize the rights and fundamental freedom of children and persons with autism through partnerships between public and private sectors; and
 - e. Recitation of *Isang Pangako* pledge during the flag raising ceremony of all government and non-government agencies on Monday, **January 15, 2018** which is cited below.
