



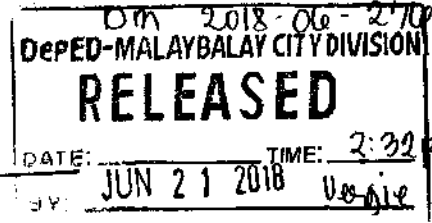

- Cyber Bullying- any bullying done through the use of technology or any electronic means (texting, email, chatting, online games, etc.)
