

- 1. This Office directs all schools to observe the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) in accordance with DepEd Order No. 25, s. 2018 entitled School Calendar for School Year 2017-2018. This is pursuant to fixecutive Order No. 29, s. 2017 entitled Renaming the National Disaster Consciousness Month to National Disaster Resilience Month and Shifting its Focus from Disaster Awareness Building to Disaster Resilience, with the theme Katatagan sa Kalamidad ay Makakamtan Kapag Sapat ang Kaalaman sa Kahandaan.
- 2. In view of this, all schools are expected to undertake relevant activities that emphasize building disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas of disasters, namely, disaster prevention and mitigation, disaster preparedness, disaster response, and disaster rehabilitation and recovery in the month of July. Conduct of such activities may vary from one or more of the following:
  - a. display of streamers indicating this year's theme (Enclosure A);
  - b. devoting time for discussion of preparedness, mitigation and prevention during the rainy season in the class or symposium/forum on DRRM;
  - c. conduct of on-the-spot poster making, jingle-making, quiz bowl, class debate, and essay writing contests; and
  - d. other related activities to:

MONTH (NDRM)

- i. ensure heightened awareness and consciousness among school administrators, teachers, personnel and school children nationwide on what to do before, during and after the occurrence of all forms of possible hazards in their respective areas; and
- strengthen the capacity of individual learners and DepEd personnel to adapt to and recover from the effects of hazards and disaster through effective risk management.

- 3. Photos during the conduct of activities in schools shall be posted in **DepEd Malaybalay DRRMers** Facebook group using the hashtags #resilientMalaybalayLearners and #resiliencePH for monitoring purposes.
- 4. Accomplishment reports of each school shall be presented during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter School DRRM Coordinators Meeting on July 27, 2018 (Friday) using the guidelines found in Enclosure B.

## GUIDELINES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

General Instruction: Accomplishment Report for the observance of 2018 National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) shall be presented through a Gallery Walk.

### **Specific Instructions:**

- 1. Each School DRRM Coordinator must prepare their accomplishment report in a whole sheet of Manila Paper.
- 2. Print Pictures that proves the conduct of the activities in a bond paper and paste them on the Manila Paper. The size of each picture must be at least 4R. They must be grouped by activities conducted and must be labeled and captioned properly.
- Selection of pictures shall be under the discretion of the School DRRM Coordinator.
   Reminder: Use only pictures that were taken during this year's observation of NDRM.
- 4. Orientation (landscape or portrait) of the Manila Paper does not matter.
- 5. There will be a designated area where Manila Papers can be posted for each school.
- 6. Participants will be given twenty (20) minutes to roam around the gallery.

After the gallery walk, ten (10) minutes will be allotted for answer and question portion.
