



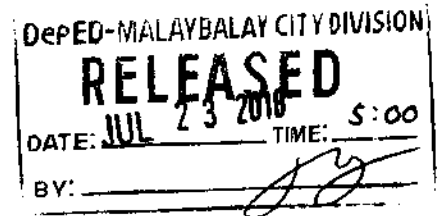

**SUBJECT: CONDUCT OF POSTER MAKING CONTEST FOR THE 22<sup>ND</sup> ANNUAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST "APOY, BAGYO, KALAMIDAD: DIBUHONG PAMBATA OR ABKD"**

4. The winners in Category A and B during the Division Screening shall be the Division's representatives to the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Poster Making Contest "Apoy, Bagyo, Kalamidad: Dibuhong Pambata or ABKD" which will be held on July 31, 2018 at NEAP-R10, Lapanan, Cagayan de Oro City.

**CONTEST MECHANICS FOR SCHOOL LEVEL AND DIVISION LEVEL**

1. The contest is open to all students aged 7 to 9 years old for Category A and 10-12 years old for Category B. All participants must be currently enrolled for school year 2018-2019.
2. Participants will choose only ONE theme per artwork in their respective category.

CATEGORY A (7-9 years old)	CATEGORY B (10-12 years old)

3. Contestants shall provide their own drawing materials coloring materials, limited to crayons, oil pasters, coloring pencils, water color, poster paints, markers, and 20”x15” (1/4) size illustration board. Artwork shall follow a PORTRAIT orientation.
4. The winner shall be judged using the following criteria: Originality and Creativity (60%), Relevance to the Chosen Theme (30%), and Neatness of Artwork (10%) for a total of 100%.
5. Three winners shall be declared. Only the first placer’s artwork shall be forwarded to the Division Office for further screening.
6. Artworks of the first placers in the school-level contests shall be submitted to Jimdandy S. Lucine, Project Development Officer II (DRRM) on or before **July 25, 2018 (Wednesday)** for division screening. **Artworks submitted late shall be disqualified.**
7. The winners in Category A and B during the Division Screening shall be the Division’s representatives to the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Poster Making Contest “Apoy, Bagyo, Kalamidad: Dibuhong Pambata or ABKD” which will be held on July 31, 2018 at NEAP-R10, Lapanan, Cagayan de Oro City.

1. This Office, in coordination with the Citizens' Disaster Response Center Inc. (CDRC), will conduct the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Poster Making Contest "Apoy, Bagyo, Kalamidad: Dibuhong Pambata or ABKD" on July 31, 2018, 9:00 AM, at NEAP-R10, Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City.
2. The Schools Division Offices shall each send two (2) Grade School pupils participants for Category A (7 - 9 years old) and for Category B (10 - 12 years old). Only one coach shall accompany the participants.
3. The participants of the Poster Making Contest shall use their own drawing and coloring materials, limited to crayons, oil pastels, coloring pencils, water color, poster paints, markers, and 20"X15" (¼) size illustration board.
4. The artwork shall follow a PORTRAIT orientation. No text or mark identifying the participant should appear on the artwork.
5. The output of the activity shall be submitted immediately to the Citizens' Disaster Response Center Foundation, Inc., 72-A Times Street, West Triangle Homes, Quezon City. Details and mechanics of this contest are provided in Enclosure No. 1 of this Region Memorandum.
6. Travel and incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
