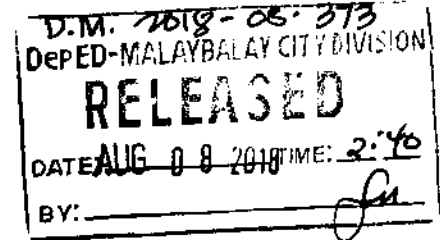

**FIRST NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION COOPERATIVES**

1. The Department of Education Cooperative (DepEdCoop), in coordination with the DepEd Employee Associations Coordinating Office (DEACO), will conduct the **First National Convention of DepEd Cooperatives** with the theme **One DepEd Cooperative: Gearing Towards Unity and Synergy** from September 26 to 28, 2018 at the Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

2. The convention aims to gather all DepEd cooperatives in the country to acquaint themselves with one another, and to strengthen the relation and coordination of DepEd management and the cooperatives in promoting the welfare of its teaching and nonteaching members. The objectives are to:

- a. develop solidarity and commitment among DepEd cooperatives;
- b. identify priority areas for the welfare and development of the cooperatives and its members based on the common needs such as:
 - i. Promotion of Frugality and Savings;
 - ii. Making a bigger cooperative through business and livelihood programs;
 - iii. Promotion of Health, Wellness and Beauty, and Life insurance; and
 - iv. Cooperative How To's.
- c. establish synergy among DepEd cooperatives in order to attain greater success in serving the needs of its members.

3. Participants are teaching and nonteaching personnel who are officers and management staff of the different DepEd cooperatives from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. Attendance to this activity is **on official time only**.

4. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for the food and accommodation, convention kits, honoraria of resource persons and facilitators, and other incidental expenses charged to their respective cooperative funds.

5. Registration forms shall be accessed, filled-out, and submitted online at bit.ly/NCDepEdCoop2018. Payment of registration fee shall be deposited at Landbank Account Number 3342-1010-02, account name: DepEd Cooperative. Registration forms shall be submitted, together with the proof of payment of the registration fee (scanned copy of deposit slip), on or before **August 15, 2018** at email address: depedcoop@yahoo.com.

6. Arrival of the participants shall be on **September 26** (Day 0). First meal to be served is dinner on Day 0, and the last meal is breakfast on **September 29, 2018**.

7. Participants may promote/exhibit their cooperative's products and services through the exhibition booths installed within the vicinity of the Baguio Teachers Camp during the National Convention.
