



CREATING THE LOCAL TRAFFICKING WOMEN AND VIOLENCE AGAINST AND CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC)

WHEREAS, Section 14, Article II of the 1987 Constitution declares that the State recognizes the role of women in nation-building and shall ensure the fundamental equity. before the law of women and men;

WHEREAS, Section 2, Article II of the same Constitution likewise provides that the State values the dignity of every human person and guarantees full respect for human rights;

WHEREAS, consonant with the State's obligation to protect the dignity of every human person, Republic Act 9208 or the Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003 was signed into law criminalizing the act of trafficking in persons especially of women and children for prostitution, sexual exploitation and slavery, among others;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9262 or the Ant-violence Against Women and their Children (VAWC) Act of 2004 was passed into law primarily to safeguard the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect of their human rights and to protect them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security;

WHEREAS, to establish and strengthen the local structure that will collaboratively address the problem on trafficking and VAWC, Joint Memorandum. Circular No. 2010-1 of the Department of Interior and Local Government, Department of Social Welfare and Development and Department of Justice have issued a Joint & Memorandum Circular No. 2010-1 directing the local government units to create local committees on trafficking and violence against women and children;

NOW THEREFORE, I, IGNACIO W. ZUBIRI, City Mayor of Malaybalay City. Bukidnon, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the creation of the Local Council on Anti-trafficking and Violence against Women and their Children (LCAT-VAW):

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION: The following shall compose the Local Council on Anti-Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children for the City of Malaybalay:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE LOCAL COUNCIL ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING, AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC) — The Council shall:

- a) Formulate a comprehensive and integrated program to prevent and suppress trafficking in persons;
- b) Promulgate rules and regulations as may be necessary for the effective implementation of the provisions of RA 9208 and RA 9262;

- d) Coordinate the programs and projects of various member agencies to effectively address the issues and problems attendant to trafficking in persons:
- e) Coordinate the conduct of massive information dissemination and campaign on the existence of the law and various issues and problems attendant to trafficking through LGUs concerned agencies, and NGOs:
- f) Direct other agencies to immediately respond to the problems brought to their attention and report to the Council on action taken;
- g) Assist in filing of cases against individuals, agencies, institutions for establishments that violate the provisions of Republic Act No. 9262 and Republic Act 9208;
- h) Secure from any department, bureau, office, agency or instrumentality of the government or from NGOs and other civic organizations such as assistance as may be needed to effectively implement the aforementioned of the said Acts;
- i) Complement share for government information system for migration established under Republic Act No. 8042 otherwise known as the Migrant Workers and Overseas Filipinos Act of 1995 with data on cases of trafficking in persons, and ensure that the proper agencies conduct a continuing research and study on the patterns and scheme of trafficking in persons which shall form the basis for policy formulation and program direction;
- j) Exercise all the powers and perform such other functions necessary to attain the purposes of the said Acts;

SECTION 3. THE SECRETARIAT. The Staff of the City Social Welfare and Development Office shall act as the secretariat to the Local Council on Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and their Children.

SECTION 4. CESSATION TO HOLD OFFICE BY ANY MEMBER OF LOCAL COUNCIL ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC). Should any member of the LCAT-VAWC cease to hold his/her office by reason of permanent incapacity, removal, resignation or the likes, the person who succeeded or is appointed in that particular office/position shall automatically become a member hereof.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless sooner revoked by another order.
