ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR SEAMEO TEACHEXCELS (BATCH 8), SUPEREXCELS (BATCH 1), GURO 21 COURSE 1 (BATCH 8), AND GURO 21 COURSE 2 (BATCH 2)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

This Region

- 1. The Department of Education Region X, in coordination with South East Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO), provides school heads, regional and divisional supervisors, public school district supervisors, department heads, master teachers, education program specialists, and teachers with opportunities for continuing education and training in advanced level tasks through competency-based, multi-modal, and modularized flexible learning courses that utilize a web-based learning management platform known as INNOTECH Flexible Learning Management System or iFLEx. The SEAMEO online courses for CY 2019-2020 consist of the following:
 - a. TEACHEXCELS or Teaching-Learning Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia (Batch 8) is a two-module, four-week online learning short course designed to enhance the instructional leadership skills of school heads in managing and supporting the teaching-learning processes in schools. Course fee is eleven thousand pesos (Php 11,000.00) per participant;
 - b. SUPEREXCELS or Supervision Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia (Batch 1) is a three-module, six-week online learning short course designed to enhance skills and management techniques in development, differentiated, and clinical supervision for school heads/supervisors/public school district supervisors who conduct instructional supervision. Course fee is sixteen thousand pesos (Php 16, 000.00) per participant;
- c. GURO 21 COURSE 1 or Gearing up Responsible and Outstanding Teachers in Southeast Asia for the 21st Century (Batch 8) entitled "Facilitating the Development of 21st Century Skills for Southeast Asian Teachers" is a two-module, four-week online learning short course aimed at addressing the teachers' needs in relation to the technological advances and changing educational trends of the 21st century. It is also expected to enhance the teachers' knowledge,

skills, attitudes, and values on teaching and learning in the new century. The GURO 21 Course 1 is considered a foundation course for the series of GURO 21 courses. It is strongly recommended that teachers successfully complete the GURO21 Course 1 before proceeding to take the other GURO21 courses. GURO21 Course 1 fee is seven thousand pesos (Php 7,000.00) per participant; and

- d. GURO 21 COURSE 2 or Gearing up Responsible and Outstanding Teachers in Southeast Asia for the 21st Century (Batch 2) entitled "Developing Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS)" is a two-module, four-week online learning short course aimed to integrate higher thinking skills into the teachers' life in order to adequately meet the challenges of the 21st century in a more systematic manner and to develop higher order thinking skills in his/her students. Course fee is seven thousand five hundred pesos (Php 7,500.00) per participant.
- 2. Each of the SEAMEO INNOTECH's online courses is creditable for fifteen (15) units for Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and three (3) academic units for an appropriate graduate/post-graduate degree program at Capitol University, Cagayan de Oro City provided that graduates are certified by SEAMEO INNOTECH as having acquired certain prescribed competencies.
- 3. Course fees, travel and other incidental expenses during the Orientation and Revalida shall be charged to local funds, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

EXCELLENCE IN SCHOOL LEADERSHIP (eXCELS) PROGRAM OF SEAMEO INNOTECH

1. The Excellence in School Leadership (eXCELS) Program of SEAMEO INNOTECH is offered to provide DepEd school heads and other education managers with opportunities for continuing education and training in advanced level tasks through competency-based, multi-modal, modularized flexible learning courses that utilize the web-based learning management platform known as the INNOTECH Flexible Learning Management System or iFLEX. The eXCELS Program consists the following courses:

Advanced eXCELS

- a. **TRACHEXCELS** (Teaching-Learning Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) is a two-module, four-week on-line learning short course designed to enhance the instructional leadership skills of school heads in managing and supporting the teaching-learning processes in schools;
- b. **SUPEREXCELS** (Supervision Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) is a three-module, six week online learning short course designed to enhance skills and management techniques in development, differentiated, and clinical supervision for school heads who conduct instructional supervision;
- c. **TECHEXCELS** (Technology Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) is a two-module, four-week on-line learning short course designed to build the capacity of school heads to manage the integration and application of technologies in the teaching-learning process.

Other cXCELS

- d. **PEACEXCELS** (Peace Education Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) is a two module, four-week on-line learning shortcourse designed to enhance the competencies of school in promoting and practicing a culture of peace and respect for cultural diversity in schools:
- e. CHANGEXCELS (Change Management Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia) is a four-week on-line short course on Leading and Managing Change consisting of two self-instructional modules and interactive simulator game on managing change. The course is designed to equip school heads with competencies to become change leaders and managers as well as transformers of the future within and beyond their school and community; and
