

Participants: Junior, Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts

Minimum of 50 delegates per council, no limit to the maximum.

#### Oualification:

- All delegates must be registered Girl Scouts as of March 8, 2019.
- Must be physically fit with Health Examination Form duly signed by the participant and physician.
- Must have attended the Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course.
- 4. Must have attended a patrol pre-camp training.
- Must have 2 chaperons for every 6-8 Junior Girl Scouts.

Note: The adult chaperons for Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts can only assist their girls during settling down. They will attend the Troop Leader's Forum in a separate venue intended for them.
