EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12 Series of 2019

AN ORDER SUSPENDING THE AFTERNOON CLASSES (MARCH 19, 2019) IN ALL ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL LEVELS IN THE CITY OF MALAYBALAY DUE TO MODERATE/HEAVY RAINFALL BROUGHT BY TYPHOON "CHEDENG".

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) has announced that typhoon "Chedeng" has made landfall in Mindanao this morning:

WHEREAS, due to the said typhoon, the City of Malaybalay is experiencing moderate to heavy rainfall since early this morning and per PAGASA Severe Weather Bulletin No. 11, Northern Mindanao areas will still experience moderate to heavy rainfall;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 66, series of 2012, authorized local chief executives of local government units to suspend classes for both public and private schools for the safety and welfare of pupils and students in the event of typhoons and other weather disturbances;

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Malaybalay City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office, there is a need to suspend the afternoon classes in all elementary and high school levels for both private and public schools in the City of Malaybalay due to moderate / heavy rainfall to ensure the safety and welfare of the pupils and students;

NOW, THEREFORE I, IGNACIO W. ZUBIRI, by the powers vested upon me by laws as City Mayor of Malaybalay, hereby declare the suspension of afternoon classes (March 19, 2019) in all elementary and high school levels for both private and public schools in the City of Malaybalay, Bulcidnon.
