SUBJECT: RUBRICS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION

1. Corollary to DepEd Order No. 002, s. 2019 **Re: School Year 2018-2019 K to 12 Basic Education Program End of School Year Rites**, this Office hereby directs the field for an appropriate solemn ceremony thus presentation of candidates for graduation among school heads shall use the enclosed rubrics.

2. The evaluation will be of two categories: 1) Grade 6 Graduation Ceremony and 2) Grade 12 (Senior High School) Graduation Ceremony.

3. Further, be guided of these general procedures:

a. A school personnel/teacher shall be assigned as official video recorder to capture a 30-second processional scene, presentation of candidates for graduation by the school head, systematic reaction of the graduates to the presentation and the confirmation of the confirming official.

b. A soft copy will be submitted through manuel.dinlayan@deped.gov.ph on or before April 5, 2019.

c. Once submitted, it will serve as the school head's official entry to the evaluation.

RUBRIC / CRITERIA FOR THE CONTEST
PRESENTATION OF THE CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION

CATEGORY	DESCRIPTION	POINTS
Posture and Eye Contact	Stands up straight. Looks relaxed and confident. Establishes eye contact with the audience or concerned individual.	30
Pitch and Volume	Pitch was often used and it conveyed emotions appropriately. Volume is loud enough to be heard by all audience.	30
Speaks Clearly	Speaks clearly and distinctly all the time, and mispronounces no words.	20
Preparedness	Has obviously rehearsed as seen in candidates response during the presentation.	10
Time-Limit	Presentation is within time allotment as prescribed in the Graduation Rites Script (Presentation)	10
