SUBJECT: OBSERVANCE OF THE 2019 NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE

**MONTH (NDRM)** 

1. July is **National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM)** as stated in DepEd Order No. 7, s. 2019 entitled *School Calendar for School Year 2019-2020*. In view of this, all schools are encouraged to undertake relevant activities that emphasize building disaster resilience such as but not limited to the following:

- a. devoting time for discussion of disaster preparedness, mitigation and prevention in the class or symposium/forum on DRRM;
