In relation to the approved memorandum no. OUA-MEMO-12-0119-0083 "CY 2019 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills" and NDRRMC Memorandum No. 63s, 2019 "Conduct of the CY 2019 Third Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)", the event and the quarterly periodical exam are scheduled on the same date, **08 August 2019**.
