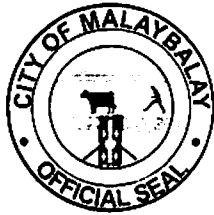

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27-A**

**DESIGNATING MRS. PACITA L. COSTONERA AS  
CHAIRWOMAN OF THE OFFICE OF SENIOR  
CITIZENS AFFAIRS (OSCA) OF THE CITY OF
