**AN ORDER SUSPENDING THE CLASSES AND WORK TODAY  
(OCTOBER 29, 2019) IN ALL LEVELS OF PUBLIC AND  
PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND ALL DEPARTMENTS AND OFFICES  
OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MALAYBALAY DUE TO 6.4  
MAGNITUDE EARTHQUAKE**

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 66, Series of 2012 authorized local chief executives of local government units to suspend classes on both public and private schools in the event of serious weather disturbance affecting their locality;

**WHEREAS**, the said Executive Order allows a local chief executive as chairman of the *Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC)* to cancel or suspend classes in the presence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA and other calamities;

**WHEREAS**, due to 6.4 magnitude earthquake which had an epicenter at Tulunan, Cotabato and the series of after-shocks the CDRRMC advised the LGU of Malaybalay City of the eminent danger to the public and the need to suspend the classes and work today (October 29, 2017) in all levels of public and private schools within the City of Malaybalay and to all Departments and Offices of the Local Government of Malaybalay City to ensure the safety of pupils, students and employees of the City.

**NOW THEREFORE, I HON. FLORENCIO T. FLORES, JR.**, Mayor of the City of Malaybalay, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the suspension of classes and work today (October 29, 2017) in all levels of private and public schools within the City of Malaybalay and to all Departments and Offices of the Local Government of the same except those in the disaster response units.
