The City Government of Malaybalay would like to express our heartfelt gratitude for your support to our environmental conservation and protection services particularly on the field of ecological solid waste management. The implementation of the proper waste segregation, storage and disposal in our city will not be sustained without your commitment and support.

Be informed that for this year, the City Government of Malaybalay intends to intensify our ESWM compliance to what are mandated under the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act (RA 9003). Starting this year, we will be increasing our mandatory waste diversion targets to cope up the national target by diverting our biodegradable solid wastes from reaching to our disposal facility. This can be done by implementing the backyard/household/barangay and community-based composting and waste retention.

Starting this year, the City Government will be reducing the collection of biodegradable solid wastes from the 14 barangays covered in the collection of both biodegradable and non-biodegradable solid wastes. Section 10 of RA 9003 mandates that segregation and collection of solid waste shall be conducted at the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes: Provided, that the collection of non-recyclable materials and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the municipality or city. In addition, Section 1 of Rule XI of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9003 mandates the Barangays to be responsible for the collection, segregation, recycling of biodegradable, recyclable, compostable and reusable wastes.

In relation, may we inform you that the collection of biodegradable solid wastes from your office/institution/establishment are now suspended effective November 18, 2019. The details of this concern was already relayed to the officials of your barangay months ahead prior to the effectivity of this directive. Please coordinate with your barangay officials for guidance and for the proper management of your generated biodegradable solid wastes.

Anticipating that this concern be given your preferential attention and be properly disseminated.
