COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The MVP Future Thought Leader's Summit (MVP-FTLS) is FPLA's annual youth leadership development program crafted specifically to enhance the knowledge, skills and attitude for future leaders and innovators.

DURATION:

3.5 Days (January 26 to 29, 2020)

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Gather student leaders: The summit aims to gather 90 outstanding public school student leaders from 15 different schools from different parts of the Philippines.
- Enhance their individual and collective leadership skills: The summit aims to use FPLA's Student Leadership Development Framework as a program outline to enhance their leadership capabilities. Moreover, the participants will be conscious about present issues we are facing today as a society.
- Develop and actualize a social entrepreneurship project: The participants are ready with their social entrepreneurship ideas in support with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) upon application. The summit will be a platform for the development of the ideas that the participants may potentially incubate and will help their respective communities in their communal issues and problems – and has a potential to help thousands of people.
