SUBJECT: 2020 METROBANK- MTAP- DEPED MATH CHALLENGE

1. Relative to DepEd Memorandum No. 144, s. 2019 entitled 2020 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge the following are the schedule:

Competition Phase	Date
Elimination Round	January 16, 2020 Elementary Level January 17, 2020 Junior High School Level
Division Finals	February 6, 2020 Elementary Level February 7, 2020 Junior High School Level

2. The overall objective of the competition is to contribute in improving the quality of Mathematics education in the Philippines. Specifically, it aims to:

- awaken greater interest in Mathematics among elementary and secondary students in both public and private schools all over the country;
- challenge them to strive for mathematical excellence, and
- empower mathematical talents with awards and recognitions for them to serve as models to the youth.

3. The contestants are all bonafide students enrolled in Grades 1 to 10 in any Public and Private School who are registered online. Only three (3) pupils/students per grade level shall represent each school, for both public and private.

4. The Division Elimination Round-Elementary shall be conducted in four (4) clusters. The ten Districts including private elementary schools are geographically clustered as follows:

- Cluster 1: Malaybalay City District 1, 2 and 3
- Cluster 2: Malaybalay City District 4, 5 and 6
- Cluster 3: Malaybalay City District 7, 8 and 9
- Cluster 4: Malaybalay City District 10

5. The Division Elimination Round-Secondary shall be conducted at Malaybalay City National High School for both Public and Private Schools.

6. The competition shall be held simultaneously on the following Testing Centers:

8. The Private elementary shall join the competition to the district where they belong.

9. The Opening Program for the Division Elimination round and Finals should be made at **8:00 am** where the package of test questionnaires shall be **opened publicly** and to be witnessed by the Branch Manager or Schools Division Superintendent.

10. The Team Orals should be conducted in three (3) different venues (Grades 1-2 in one Venue, Grades 3-4 in another Venue and Grades 5-6 in another Venue) while High School in two (2) different Venues (Grades 7-8 in one venue and Grade 9-10 in another venue). The competition should be held simultaneously, preferably on the stage, inside the gym or any function room that can accommodate audience for the competition.

11. The **Division Finals Elementary** shall be conducted at **Airport Village Elementary School, Malaybalay City** while the **Junior High School** shall be at **Bukidnon National High School, Malaybalay City**. The following schedule of competition shall be followed:

2020 METROBANK-MTAP-DEPED MATH CHALLENGE

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) announces the **2020 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge (MMC)** from January to March 2020. This competition will be conducted by the Metrobank Foundation Inc. (MBFI), and the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP), in cooperation with the DepEd regional and schools division offices.

2. The overall objective of the competition is to ensure maximum participation in improving the quality of Mathematics Education in the Philippines. Specifically, it aims to

- a. awaken greater interest in Mathematics among elementary and junior high school learners in the country,
- b. challenge them to strive for mathematical excellence, and
- c. empower mathematical talents with awards and recognitions for them to serve as models to the youth.

3. The **Eliminations and Division Level** Competitions will be participated in by elementary and junior high school learners nationwide. However, **only Grades 6 and 10 learners can participate in the Regional and National Finals.**

4. **All public and private schools** are required to register online using the **Online MMC Form No. 1** at <http://metrobankmathchallenge.com>. Interested participants are requested to read Enclosure No. 4: Instruction Guide for the Online MMC Form No. 1 (MMC Document No. 4).

- a. Only schools located in far-flung and hard-to-reach areas from **pre-identified schools division offices** have the option to manually submit hard copies of the MMC Form No. 1 to their respective Division Math Supervisors **on or before October 25, 2019**. The list of the pre-identified schools division offices and schools can be found in Enclosure No. 5: Guidelines on the Manual Submission of Hard Copy MMC Form No. 1 (MMC Document No. 5).

Schools that have internet access from the identified schools divisions should still register online.

- b. The **Division Math Supervisors** shall collate and send a scanned copy in one pdf file of the manually submitted MMC Form No. 1 to the MMC Secretariat at **secretariat.mathchallenge@gmail.com on or before October 30, 2019**. The email subject should indicate the name of the schools division office, number of entries, MMC Form No. 1, e.g. Division of Apayao, 19 entries, MMC Form No. 1.
- c. The MMC Secretariat shall encode the MMC Form No. 1 a week after receiving the email and shall inform the Division Math Supervisors once encoding is completed, through email and text message, **on or before November 5, 2019**.
- d. Once all MMC Form No. 1 are encoded, the Division Math Supervisors shall accomplish MMC Form No. 2 or the tagging of schools to its testing centers.

The schools division offices in hard-to-reach areas were identified by the MMC Secretariat through the following criteria:

- i. Majority of schools have no access to internet and mobile data connection, and
 - ii. Geographical location is challenging, which limits an individual to travel to nearby areas where internet connection is available.
- e. The **Division Math Supervisors** are required to accomplish the MMC Form No. 2 through the MMC online portal at **http://www.onlineportal.metrobankmathchallenge.com**. This shall serve as the official entry and intent of the schools division in joining the MMC. Failure to do so shall be grounds for disqualification.

5. For the **National Capital Region (NCR)**, schools shall be tagged and compete under the following categories:

6. The school contestants and their respective coaches must present the printed copy of their Online MMC Form No. 1 (email confirmation) to the registration in-charge, together with their identification cards, during the Elimination Round on **January 16, 2020** (elementary) or **January 17, 2020** (junior high school). It will serve as their permit in joining the competition. A **no permit, no entry** policy shall be implemented.

7. The **Division Math Supervisors** shall be in-charge of the preparation, implementation and documentation of the Eliminations and Division Competitions, including preparation of the program and fielding of qualified officials to serve as judges, proctors, and hosts/quizmasters. They, together with the appointed members of the board of judges, will also be responsible for settling all questions and protests, which may arise in the course of the competition. To maintain security and confidentiality of the test questions, the turnover of the test materials

will be documented, and all packages in different stages of the competition will be opened simultaneously at 9:00 a.m. on the date of the competition. **MMC Document 2: Operating Guidelines should be read as new policies shall be strictly implemented.**

8. For the **Regional Finals**, the **Regional Mathematics Supervisors** shall be in-charge of the preparation, implementation and documentation, including the preparation of program, designation of judges, proctors, correctors for the individual competition and hosts/quizzmasters. Representatives from MTAP will assist in facilitating this stage of the competition, both in the individual and team categories. They will also be responsible for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition.

9. Travel of MTAP representatives who will assist DepEd regional offices to organize and conduct the Regional Finals shall be **on official time**.

10. For the **National Finals**, the MBFI shall be in-charge of the preparation, implementation, and documentation. Enclosure No. 2: Operating Guidelines (MMC Document No. 2) includes the qualifications of national finalists.

11. In compliance to the no-collection policy of DepEd, as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, **no registration fees shall be collected from participating schools in all phases of the competition.**

12. From the elimination round to the regional level competition, the participants shall shoulder expenses, such as transportation and meal expenses. At the national level, the MBFI shall finance the transportation expenses, accommodation and meal allowance of the national finalists and their coaches. MBFI shall also provide the awards for the winners from the division finals (medals) to the regional and national finals (cash incentives, medals, and trophies). Cash incentives will also be awarded to the coaches of regional and national finalists.

14. In case of conflict in schedule with other DepEd activities, the schools division and regional offices are advised to assign focal persons to administer the tests at the schools division and/or regional levels on the scheduled dates.

Note: There will be no sectoral finals for NCR.

15. Changes in schedule of the elimination rounds and division finals shall only be allowed upon approval of the National Steering Committee and on the following grounds:

- a. Competition coincides with the celebration of a local holiday, or
- b. Schools Division is affected by a natural calamity.

The schools division office must inform the MMC National Steering Committee at least two weeks before the original competition schedule.

16. Changes in the schedule of the regional finals will not be allowed due to significant implications in the logistical and technical preparations. Any delay will also affect the conduct of the national finals.

17. Arrangements for substitute teachers must be made to ensure that the classes of the participating teacher-coaches will not be disrupted.

18. Should a competition be rescheduled on a Saturday, DepEd personnel who will organize and facilitate the events shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credit to Teachers. Nonteaching personnel shall be provided compensatory time-off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.

19. The Division Math Supervisors shall submit a completion report on the conduct of the elimination and division finals on or before **February 10, 2020**. Only an electronic copy of the report should be submitted through email at secretariat.mathchallenge@gmail.com.
