- 1. Participants must be registered Junior/Senior Girl Scouts
- 2. Each District (Junior)/School (Senior) shall have 1 entry with 12-15 dancers.
- 3. Each group will be given 3-5 minutes to perform including entrance and exit. Excess in time will have 1 point deduction per 30 seconds to the final score per judge.
- 4. Costumes/steps must be closest to the originality of the country represented.
- 5. Use of hand props will be allowed as long as it will not cause any delay in the program.
- 6. The decision of the board of judges is final.

Criteria:

Choreography (creativity & style) - 40%
Execution (timing, coordination & expression) - 30%
Costume/Props (closest to originality of the country represented 20%
Overall Impact 10%
Total 100%
