The Department of Health through the City Health Office yearly does the Human Papiluma Virus (HPV) vaccination with the Grade IV female pupils of the primary grade schools of the city. This vaccine is only specific to this age. The vaccine primarily generates specific antibodies that bind to the virus and prevent cervical infections. By having these children receive the vaccination is one measure to protect them from cervical cancer at an early age.

Anent to this, we would like to ask permission to allow the Rural Health Midwives to vaccinate in the schools as soon as possible. We just would like to have their entries to the schools permitted to defy refusals.
