EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75 Series of 2020

AN ORDER CANCELLING THE CROWD-DRAWING AND MASS GATHERING ACTIVITIES FOR THE 22nd CHARTER DAY ANNIVERSARY OF THE CITY OF MALAYBALAY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

In compliance with the unnumbered Department of Health Advisory and the Memorandum No. 431, s. 2020 issued by Governor Jose Ma. R. Zubiri, Jr., recommending and ordering the cancellation of big events or mass gatherings in view of the threat of the spread of 2019 novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV ARD) and to ensure the safety and health of the public, all activities which are crowd-drawing and/or mass gatherings in connection with the celebration of the 22nd Charter Day Celebration are hereby CANCELLED.

Further, barangays are also hereby ordered to CANCEL all their activities which will draw or entail gathering of large crowds in their respective jurisdictions.


Public and private schools and offices, private establishments and other associations and the general public are hereby strongly urged to CANCEL and/or AVOID organizing, attending or participating in events or activities that draw a huge number of attendees or crowds.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
