## **REGIONAL YOUTH FORUM**





SUBJECT

: REGIONAL YOUTH FORUM

- 1. The Bukidnon Council, BSP will be sending participants to the Regional Youth Forum on March 09-14, 2020 at BSP Camp, Malagos, Calinan, Davao City.
- 2. Participants must be a Senior Scouts who are grade 7 to Grade 11 or who are 14 to 17 ½ year of age during the youth forum.
- 3. The Scout Youth forum, a primordial part of the Youth Development Program, is organized to fill in the need and the glamour for youth participation in the decision-making process in the Scout Movement. It is a place of information, training and concrete experience of discussing and acquiring a deeper understanding of various issues. It is also source of inspiration by providing the contact with new people, fresh ideas, innovative thoughts, different e4xperiences and working methods.
- 4. The highlights of the Scout Youth Forum is to determine the Six (6) Scout representatives to the National Scout Youth Forum on March 10-12, 2020 right after the closing ceremony of the Regional Youth Forum on March 10, 2020 at 1:30 PM.
- 5. Participants and accompanying Adult shall be charge of Five Hundred Pesos (**P500.00**) to defray the expenses for accommodation, food, program materials and other operational expenses.

  - c. Civilian Clothes including Jackets
  - d. Medicines and Sleeping Gears if necessary
  - e. Other personal requirements, such as toilet articles', extra Clothing, Blanket/Malong, etc. shall be part of the participant's luggage.
