1. In conformity to Executive Order No. 605, s. 2007 "All departments in the Executive Branch are directed to establish a Quality Management System (QMS) certified to the ISO 9001 Standard", Memorandum Circular No. 2018-1 dated August 17, 2018 issued by the Government Quality Management Committee (GQMC) re: Guidelines on the Validation of the ISO 9001:2015 QMS Certification as a Requirement for the Grant of the FY 2018 Performance-Based Boms (PBB), Republic Act No. 11032, otherwise known as the "Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018" enacted on May 28, 2018 which calls for government "to adopt, institutionalize and support the promotion of transparency in the transactions of the government with the public, encompassing a program for the adoption of simplified requirements and procedures aimed at the reduction of red-tape and to expedite business and non-business related transactions in government", this Office hereby informs the field about Division QMS Adherence geared towards ISO 9001:2015 Certification effective December 27, 2019 until completion of the five (5) phases such as: Analysis (Phase 1), Design and Development (Phase 2), Phase 3 (Implementation), Internal Audit (Phase 4), and Evaluation (Phase 5).
