DISASTER PREPAREDNESS, PREVENTION, AND MITIGATION

MEASURES FOR THE WET SEASON

- 1. In preparation for the inevitable wet season in the country, this Office enjoins all offices concerned to conduct disaster preparedness, prevention, and mitigation measures to ensure the safety of the personnel, vital records, and properties owned by the Department.
- 2. All are advised to conduct all, but not limited to, the following activities:
 - a. Conduct minor repairs to school buildings in order to ensure that they can withstand heavy rain and strong winds;
 - b. Identify storage area for safekeeping of learning materials, teachers' manuals, vital records and equipment (fax, laptops, computers, among other machines), preferably on an elevated room to ensure protection from rain or flood;
 - c. Reinforce policy on turning off or unplugging of electrical equipment and appliances when not in use;
 - d. School Heads must have updated contact numbers of their teaching and non-teaching personnel, while Division Human Resource Office must have updated contact numbers of school heads and Division personnel;
 - e. Make or clean the drainage system in the school;
 - f. Identify and put signage to slippery areas;
 - g. Equip school with first aid kits, flashlights, megaphones, and other necessary supplies that may be needed in times of emergencies;
 - h. Provide Personal Protective Equipment to teaching and non-teaching personnel such as, but not limited to, facemasks, face shields, sterilized gloves, and goggles;
 - i. Purchase of non-contact thermometer and medicines for colds and fever:



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- j. Conduct of 4S or 5S to combat dengue in schools; and
- k. Always maintain communication lines open.
- 3. COVID-19 prevention and control measures set forth by the School Health Section through Division Memorandum Nos. 189, s. 2020 re: COVID-19 Prevention and Control Measures in Schools and 188, s. 2020 re: Cleaning and Disinfection of DepEd School and Offices in Preparation for SY 2020-2021 in Light of COVID-19 Measures and other COVID-19 protocols established by the National Government and Local Government Unit must be followed even in times of wet season.
- 4. Expenses incurred to prepare, prevent, and mitigate disasters during the wet season in this time of pandemic shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Involvement of all school personnel, parents, and community leaders in preparing for disasters is highly encouraged for the safety of the learners and their schools.
- 6. Division Office shall conduct series of monitoring on the compliance of this Memorandum. Schools are also encouraged to post photos of their undertaking in DepED Malaybalay Infoboard Facebook Group.
