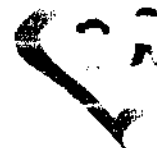

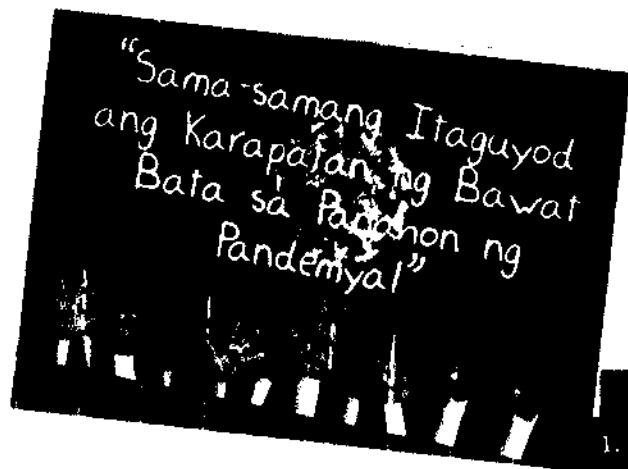

May these activities encourage our families and communities to promote and uphold the rights of the children! Thank you and God bless!

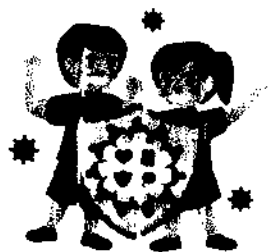

1. The greeting card making contest is open to all children aged 7-12 residing in Malaybalay City.
2. Participants of their family members who have facebook are requested to LIKE and follow our City Council for the Welfare of Children (CCWC) - Malaybalay Facebook Page before sending an entry
3. Each participant will only be allowed to submit one (1) entry
4. Participants shall design a unique greeting card using any material (e.g. oslo paper, typewriting eggshells, crayons, twigs, dried leaves, yarn, trash).
5. Design artworks can be done by coloring, painting, scrap-booking or mixed media (e.g. paper).
6. There should be a handwritten message in the card, minimum of one line, centering on the National Children's Month (NCM) Celebration Theme this year: "SAMA-SAMANG ITAGUYOD ANG KARAPATAN NG BAWAT BATA SA PANAHON NG PANDEMYA!"
7. The handwritten message could be addressed to anyone but the participant must clearly indicate to whom the greeting card is for (e.g. dear front-liners, healthcare workers, essential workers, employers, government officials, fellow children).
8. All entries must be original and owned by the participant

Entry must be scanned or photographed and the image file must be submitted in PDF, JPEG or PNG format only via e-mail to ccwcmby@gmail.com with the following subject line: NCM Malaybalay 2020 Greeting Card Making Contest. 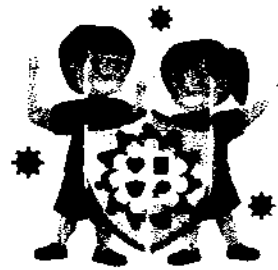
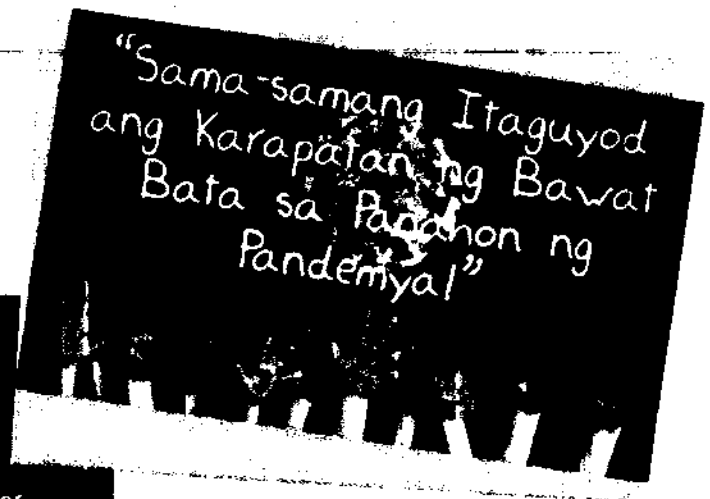
