

### MONITORING WINS PROGRAM IN THE PANDEMIC AND ASSESS THE READINESS FOR SAFE RETURN TO SCHOOLS

- 1. Regarding Department of Education (DepEd) Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018 titled Implementing Guidelines to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 (Policy and Guidelines for Comprehensive Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in School) to ensure the safety, health, and well-being of the school populace, DepEd issued the Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools (DepEd Order No. 14 s. 2020) to encourage the schools to comply with the standards set out in the WinS program, which is at the forefront in preventing the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
- 2. While schools are currently not holding face-to-face classes, infrastructure and other mitigating measures should be in place for safe school physical reopening and operations. Monitoring through the WinS monitoring tool seems to be a challenging task for the schools as there are indicators that are not relevant to the current context or cannot be answered due to the current situation. Nevertheless, most of the questions found in the monitoring tool, especially questions related to infrastructure, are answerable. However, for inapplicable questions such as numbers 13, 31, 32, 37, 38, 39, 40, 48, 49, 51, 54, 55, and 56, please respond to these questions by using the data from the previous school year.
- 3. Hence, the schools division superintendents are directed to ensure that all schools shall update their **WinS Online Monitoring System (OMS)** status by reporting their school information in the WinS Monitoring Tool within the month of **March-April**. Supervisors and school health personnel assigned to monitor the school should affix their signatures on the School WinS Monitoring Forms (Attachment No. 1) prior to encoding in the online system.

- 4. In addition to WinS OMS, Checklist to Assess the Readiness for Safe Return to School shall be conducted to elementary and secondary schools in preparation of the face-to-face classes. Data are important for providing technical assistance to the schools. A quarterly consolidated monitoring reports shall be submitted to the Regional Office (RO) on or before the fifth day of the succeeding month of the quarter (1st quarter-April 5, 2nd quarter-July 5, 3rd quarter-October 5, & 4th quarter-January 5). Attached are the forms for the school assessment and consolidation (Attachment No. 2 & 3).
- 5. The divisional WinS coordinators and school health section (SHS) heads shall spearhead in the monitoring and coordination with the schools and district offices for these activities, WinS OMS, and Checklist to assess the schools' readiness. They shall submit the quarterly consolidated reports to the RO at the schools' wind submitted by the schools' WinS coordinators to the RO.

- 8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
