**SUBJECT: DIVISION-WIDE DIGITAL PAINTING AND FIRE PREVENTION VIDEO
 MAKING CONTESTS FOR LEARNERS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE

1. By virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 115-A, the month of March was declared as Fire Prevention Month because of fire incidents happening across the country during this period. The theme for this year is **Sa Pag-Iwas sa Sunog Di Ka Nag-lisa**. Relative to this, to increase awareness, this Office shall conduct a division-wide digital painting and fire prevention video making contests for learners in public and private schools.

CONTEST MECHANICS

A. DIGITAL PAINTING

Competition Terms:

1. Digital Painting is an individual event.
2. All artwork submitted must be digital paintings created by any illustration software such as Adobe Photoshop and GIMPS.
3. There is no limitation regarding the software used to create the artworks.
4. Artwork should be anchored to the theme: **Sa Pag-iwas sa Sunog Di Ka Nag-iisa.**
5. The contest is open to all junior and senior high school students in public and private schools of DepEd-Division of Malaybalay City.
6. Every participant must have a teacher who will serve as coach.
7. Every participant can submit only one artwork.
8. Teachers can coach more than one student.
9. Submissions containing filtered photos, photo manipulations, collages or animations are NOT accepted. Entries must therefore be original.
10. Works containing pornography or promoting violence will NOT be accepted.
11. Submission is free of charge.
12. File size must NOT exceed 25 MB.
13. Only png and jpeg image file formats will be accepted.
14. All the copyrights during and after the competition belong to the participant. This Office may showcase the artworks taking part in the Competition on its website and social media and to use them for marketing purposes.

Submission Deadline:

1. Artwork submissions shall be accepted from the date of this posting up to March 24, 2021, 5:00 p.m. Late submission will not be accepted.

Awards and Winners:

1. The artworks will be posted in DepEd Malaybalay DRRM Infoboard Facebook Page on March 25 – 28, 2021. The winners will be selected based on the number of likes. They will then receive the following prizes:
 - First Place (with the greatest number of likes): Globe load cards worth 1,500 pesos and certificate
 - Second Place (with the second greatest number of likes): Globe load cards worth 1,200 pesos and certificate
 - Third Place (with the third greatest number of likes): Globe load cards worth 900 pesos and certificate

All winning coaches shall receive 600 pesos worth of Globe load cards.

B. FIRE PREVENTION VIDEO MAKING CONTESTS

Competition Terms:

1. Video making contest is a group event.
2. All videos submitted must be created by any video editing software such as Adobe Premiere and Wondershare Filmora.
3. There is no limitation regarding the software used to create the videos.
4. Videos should be about fire safety measures.
5. Animation (cartoons) or live action (real actors) will be accepted.
6. The contest is open to all junior and senior high school students in public and private schools of DepEd-Division of Malaybalay City.
7. Every team must have a teacher who will serve as coach.
8. Every team can submit only one artwork.
9. Teachers can coach more than one team.
10. Entries must be original.
11. Works containing pornography or promoting violence will NOT be accepted.
12. Submission is free of charge.
13. File size must NOT exceed 25 MB.
14. Only avi, mp4 and wmv video file formats will be accepted.
15. All the copyrights during and after the competition belong to the participant. This Office may showcase the artworks taking part in the Competition on its website and social media and to use them for marketing purposes.

Submission Deadline:

- Artwork submissions shall be accepted from the date of this posting up to March 24, 2021, 5:00 p.m. Late submission will not be accepted.

Awards and Winners:

The artworks will be posted in DepEd Malaybalay DRRM Infoboard Facebook Page on March 25 – 28, 2021. The winners will be selected based on the number of likes. They will then receive the following prices:

- First Place (with the greatest number of likes): Globe load cards worth 3,000 pesos and certificate
- Second Place (with the second greatest number of likes): Globe load cards worth 2,400 pesos and certificate
- Third Place (with the third greatest number of likes): Globe load cards worth 1,800 pesos and certificate

All winning coaches shall receive 600 pesos worth of Globe load cards.

For all contests, the winners shall be announced on March 29, 2021. Prizes can be claimed until March 31, 2021 only. Unclaimed prizes shall be forfeited.
