#### 2. Webinar on Tobacco Industry and Corruption

Participants from DepEd, especially those involved in tobacco control, are invited to a free webinar on Tobacco Industry and Corruption on May 6, 2021, 08:30 pm (Philippine Time).

Through the webinar, participants will learn about:

- a. the link between the tobacco industry and corruption, including existing evidence and the dangers of associating with the tobacco industry;
- b. tools and materials available that will help frame issues around corruption and hold the tobacco industry accountable; and
- c. practices that will promote integrity and help adopt preventive measures.
