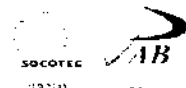

Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 322, s. 1997 titled *Authorizing Certain Government Agencies to Undertake Activities in Preparation for their Centennial Anniversary Celebrations in 1997, 1998 and 1999* and thereby recognizing June 23, 1898, as the Foundation Day of this Department, DepEd announces its **123rd Founding Anniversary** with the theme, *Bayanihan Para sa Edukasyon*.

2. *Bayanihan* is a Filipino term used to describe people working in solidarity to achieve a common goal.
