

CONTEST MECHANICS

A. DIGITAL POSTER

Competition Terms:

- 1. Digital Poster is an individual event.
- 2. All artwork submitted must be digital paintings created by any illustration software such as Adobe Photoshop and GIMPS.
- 3. There is no limitation regarding the software used to create the artworks.
- 4. Artwork should be anchored to the theme: Tamang Pamamahala't Kahandaan, Kaalaman at Pagtutulungan sa Sakuna at Pandemya'y Kalasag ng Bayan.
- The contest is open to all elementary students, junior and senior high school students, and teachers in public and private schools of DepEd-Division of Malaybalay City. Students must be an enrolled student of School Year 2020-2021 only.
- 6. Every participant can submit only one artwork.
- 7. Submissions containing filtered photos, photo manipulations, collages or animations are NOT accepted. Entries must therefore be original.
- 8. Works containing pornography or promoting violence will NOT be accepted.
- 9. Submission is free of charge.
- 10. File size must NOT exceed 25 MB.
- 11. Only png and jpeg image file formats will be accepted.
- 12. All the copyrights during and after the competition belong to the participant. Upon joining in this contest, the participants allow this Office to use and produce their artworks in digital or print format for advocacy purposes only, including but not limited to posting in the official website, Facebook Page, and brochures.

Submission Deadline:

1. Artwork submissions shall be accepted from the date of this posting up to July 16, 2021, 5:00 p.m. Late submission will not be accepted.

Awards and Winners:

- 1. The artworks will be posted in DepEd Malaybalay DRRM Infoboard Facebook Page on July 19 29, 2021.
- 2. The winners shall be selected through Public choice and Judges choice. Ranks in public choice and judges choice shall be averaged. The one with the lowest average shall be declared as the winner.
- 3. The ranks in public choice shall be determined by the number of "Likes" reaction. The one with the greatest number of likes shall have the highest rank. While in Judges choice, the criteria shall be as follows:

a. Relevance to the theme - 30%

The design should effectively communicate from the given theme.

b. Originality - 25%

It must show the ability to be inventive and creative.

c. Aesthetic Appeal - 25%

The Poster design must captivate the judges' senses, taking into consideration the aesthetic principles of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion.

d. Description of Artwork/Poster - 20%

Expression of meaning or description of the artwork in ENGLISH or TAGALOG limited to 200-300 words. This measures how well the poster makes its own theme clear to the viewers.

4. There will only be one winner in elementary category, secondary category, and teacher category. Winners will receive a certificate and a cash prize of 1,000.00 each.

Protests:

- Protests to winners will be entertained only on the following grounds:
 - The artwork was found to be not original
 - False enrolment data of the student
 - The artwork was not done by the winner
- Protests should be filed through letter at within 3 working days after the declaration of winners.
- If protest is successful, the winner declaration shall be void and nulled. Prices must be returned to this Office.
