IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR COLLEGE SCHOLARS

- 1 He/She should be a son/daughter of parents who are actually residing in the City of Malaybalay (A certification from the barangay that they are residents).
- 2 He/She must be not more than 21years of age at the time of his/her application.
- 3 He/She must be a senior high school graduate whose average is 83% or higher with no grade below 80 per subject in grade 12.
- 4 He/She must not enjoy another scholarship grant from the school or any sponsoring group.
- 5 He/She must take the qualifying competitive examination conducted by the City Government.
- 6 He/She must be financially incapable to pursue a college education whose parents annual net income does not exceed to P 150,000.00.

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF CITY SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION FOR S.Y. 2020-2021

1. Students shall undergo thermal screening as he waits to enter an examination center.
2. Students shall bring their own alcohol, ballpen and pencil.
3. Students and Facilitators shall wear face mask/faceshield at all times inside the examination center.
4. Seating arrangement shall be made in such a way that adequate social distancing is maintained.
5. Facilitators shall sanitize his/her hands prior to distribution of question papers and answer sheets.
6. The students shall also sanitize their hands before receiving such papers and handling them back to the facilitator.
7. Each classroom shall be limited to 15 students only.
8. In an open area or covered court shall be limited to 30 percent (30%) only of the capacity, provided that the 1 meter physical distancing requirement is observed.
9. Students shall provide barangay certificate that he/she is not a PUM/PLU.
