

Dear Hon. Secretary:

We write the Honorable Secretary to seek her support to the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA) scholarship programs for the dependents of Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs). These are the Education for Development Scholarship Program (EDSP) and the Congressional Migrants Workers Scholarship Program (CMWSP).

Both programs are open to graduating senior high school students whose parent/s are OFWs. To be eligible, applicants should pass the qualifying examination conducted through a partnership with the Department of Science and Technology- Science and Education Institute (DOST-SEI).

In observance of the prevailing Covid-19 protocol, by waiving the classroom-type examination, the DOST-SEI will use proxy indicators to estimate the predicted performance of scholarship applicants. One of the proxy indicators set by DOST-SEI is the historical grades for the following period:

<u>Grade</u>	<u>Grades Covered</u>
9	Average of first to fourth grading period
10	Average of first to fourth grading period
11	Average of first to second grading period (first semester) only

In view of this, may we request the permission and assistance from your good Office to allow our OWWA Regional Welfare Offices to coordinate with the DepEd Regional and Division Offices and officially collect the applicants' Form 137 from the DepEd high schools. The OWWA shall pay for the expenses that may be incurred in relation to this undertaking.

Our technical staff **Mmes. Joyce J. Dalisay**, OIC of the Planning and Program Development Division and **Sayna G. Darwin**, OWWO III, who may be reached at Tel. Nos. 8834-008 and e-mail at planning@owwa.gov.ph and ppdo@gmail.com, shall coordinate with your Office on this matter.
