

## **GUIDELINES IN CHOOSING PARTICIPANTS FOR THE 2021 NATIONAL** SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

To: Schools Division Superintendents All Others Concerned

- The 2021 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) slated in August this year is dubbed as the National Conference on Campus Journalism in the 21st Century with the theme "Pahayagang Pangkampus: Kaagapay sa Paghilom at Pagbangon ng Sambayan."
- Hence, in preparation for the upcoming NSPC, the following guidelines in identifying the participants to compose the team of Region X are reiterated. The chosen participants from this Region must satisfy the following:
  - a. Must be from the Department of Education (DepEd) or private schools;
  - b. Must have seven years and above or at least five years of experience in campus journalism (for school paper advisers);
  - c. Have a good command of the language—both English and Filipino (both spoken and written forms);
  - d. Must have been trainers or facilitators of training/workshop in journalism within the last five years (for school paper advisers);
  - e. Must have been consistently winning in the DSPC, RSPC, or NSPC (for students):
  - f. Have never been involved in any case of plagiarism;
  - g. Are able to write (with minimum editing) good articles in both languages:
  - h. Are able to use Microsoft Office and online platforms;
  - i. Will not be retiring from service in the next two years (for school paper advisers);
  - j. Are willing to spend time to train and serve other school paper advisers and campus journalists;
  - k. Are physically fit;
  - 1. Must have an available gadget/device and internet connectivity for the whole duration of the activity; and
  - m. Must have joined RSPC and NSPC.



- 4. Campus journalists shall be those from Grade 5 and below (for elementary) and Grade 7 to Grade 11 (for secondary).
- 5. The divisional journalism coordinators shall accomplish the attached template based on the corresponding assignment. The distribution of slots is in reference to the divisional performance in RSPC and NSPC and the availability of potential trainers. Submission of completed and filled out template in excel file at <a href="mailto:angelina.buaron@deped.gov.ph">angelina.buaron@deped.gov.ph</a> will be June 30. Hard copies prepared by the divisional journalism coordinators and approved by the schools division superintendents are also required for submission.
- 6. A communication allowance from the Central Office (C)O) shall be downloaded to each division to cover the official participants' expenses.
