PROPER DISPOSAL OF WORN-OUT PHILIPPINE FLAGS

1. Republic Act 8491 or known as the Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines, provides the basic rules and guidelines on the proper way of displaying, hoisting and disposing the Philippine Flag.

"Section 14 of RA 8491 states that a flag worn out through wear and tear shall not be thrown away. It shall be solemnly burned to avoid misuse or desecration. The flag shall be replaced immediately when it begins to show signs of wear and tear."

- 2. Relative hereto, this Office requires all schools to **turn-over the worn-out flags** on or before **August 6, 2021** in preparation to the first special ceremony called **"Huling Parangal sa Watawat ng Pilipinas"** (Final Honors for the Philippine Flag). All District Supervisors are requested to lead in the retrieval of the worn-out flags. The schedule of the activity will be posted in a separate memorandum.
