I. Title of Activity: TRAINING OF TEACHERS & SCHOOL HEADS ON TVL WORK IMMERSION DURING PANDEMIC

# II. MEA-TVL-WI Background

Work Immersion is one of the pre-requisite requirements for senior high school learners for graduation. It is a course that provides learners the necessary knowledge and practical skills, technical knowledge, communication, human and collaboration skills, and hone work ethics, good attitude and work habits.

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought abrupt transitions in the education context. Work immersion of senior high school were greatly affected in which the Technical Vocational Livelihood track (TVL) is one of the severely affected areas of specialization due to the pandemic. Nonetheless, the office of curriculum and instruction through the Bureau of Curriculum Development issued the guidelines for work immersion implementation during crises situations. As emphasized in this guideline, the TVL track may opt to do immersion in the following schemes:

- In School- mock environment will be provided by the school for the learners to demonstrate their skills.
- II. Home-Based- the learners shall perform activities at home. However, this scheme is only applicable for learners with available materials and tools for the skills performance.
