SUBJECT : COMMUNITY ORIENTATION ON ALS LITERACY SERVICES

1. In line with DepEd Order No. 029, s. 2021 *re: School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2021-2022*, this Office will conduct a Community Orientation on ALS Literacy Services on the whole month of September 2021 in all target Barangays in the ten districts of the Division of Malaybalay City.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. orient the community members about the ALS programs and projects;
 - b. encourage target ALS learners to enrol in ALS Programs; and
 - c. promote stakeholders' participation to the ALS programs and activities
