"PALIMANI SA MGA MAGNANAU" PROGRAM – AN ENHANCED

IMPLEMENTATION OF RADIO-BASED INSTRUCTION (RBI) FOR

SY 2021-2022

- 1. To ensure delivery of quality basic education amidst pandemic and to address the pressing need of the learners to achieve better performance while undergoing blended distance learning, this Office hereby conceptualized a strategy tagged as "Palimani sa mga Magnanau" as an enhanced implementation of Radio-based Instruction for School Year 2021-2022. This is a strategy of which the provided Self-Learning Module (SLM) Version 5 to the learners shall be accompanied with a Teacher's discussion and facilitation of learning through radio broadcast and via livestreaming for those with transistor radio or internet connection/mobile data at home. For those learners who can't access from any of these, canned materials shall be provided. Its aim is to address the learning gaps brought about by the limited interaction between the teacher and the learners as regards to the presentation of the lesson. With this, the learners and their parents may have ease in understanding and performing the activities required in the SLMs. Thus, better performance can be observed and achieved.
- 2. The said intervention is for Kindergaten and Grades 1 10 only. Its live broadcast shall commence on the second quarter of the school year. For the first quarter, the live airing shall be every Friday of the week from 10: 00a.m to 3: 00p.m which will start on September 24, 2021 Friday, at the radio station to be announced later. The first quarter radio broadcast shall focus on Beginning and Developing Reading for both English and Filipino tagged as "Alas Basa Na! Program. The intervention is purposely designed for those learners enrolled in kindergarten and identified learners with reading needs /academically challenged in Grades 1, 2 and 3 levels.

- 3. The said program can be accessed in the Official Facebook page DepEd Malaybalay City RBI Program, which is simultaneously shared to DepED Tayo Malaybalay City for its live coverage for those with strong and stable internet connection.
- 4. To ensure its implementation, this Office hereby directs all Elementary and Junior High Schools including Integrated Schools to include this program in the School BE-LCP and consistently monitor its implementation. Reports needed shall be detailed in a separate issuance.
- 5. For the teachers/advisers to help facilitate the learning of their learners through RBI Program, they are provided with the Lesson Presentation Script and recorded audio corresponding to the SLM given. The RBI materials for both the "Palimani sa mga Magnanau" and the "Alas Basa Na!" Programs can be downloaded from the Division LRMDS portal once these materials are already available.
- 6. Below is the specific time slot for "Alas Basa Na" Program

- 7. The specific schedule and the live program hosts/Teacher broadcasters for both programs shall be presented on the next issuance.
- 8. The School Heads shall be primarily responsible for supervising the implementation of this mandate in their schools, ensuring that the provisions are communicated to all concerned stakeholders in the school community. In a separate issuance, the tool as regards to its monitoring shall be provided.
