PASIKLABAN 2021 CONTEST GUIDELINES

- 1. The participants are reminded to observe and follow minimum health standards such as wearing of facemasks/face shields, regular hand washing, using disinfectants like alcohol and sanitizers, and observing physical distancing, consistent with the guidelines from Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF), Department of Health (DOH), and the Department of Education (DepEd) and local government units (LGUs).
- 2. The contest is open to all public school teachers in the division.
- 3. The contest is open to any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting, etc.
- 4. Each interested individual or group shall coordinate with their school head/district supervisor for the application.
- 5. The performance will be pre-recorded and the videographer can utilize different angles using a mobile phone, digital camera, among other means. The presentation should last for a maximum of **three (3) minutes only**.
- 6. Once the video recording is available, contestants shall upload the video with a brief caption: PASIBLABAN 2021_District_School not later than September 30, 2021 to: woodrowwilson.merida@deped.gov.ph
- 7. The criteria for judging are as follows:

Talent, Interpretation and Skill – 50 % Originality and Creativity - 25 %

Projection and Overall Impact - 25 %

8. Top three (3) entries will receive certificates and a token.
