ATTACHMENT 1

GUIDELINES / MECHANICS FOR STORY TELLING

(Pre-Recorded)

Elementary School Teacher (English)

Grades 4 or 5 or 6 Learner (Filipino)

1. The contest will be participated by an Elementary Teacher for English and a Grade 4/5 or 6 Learner for Filipino.
2. Each district is allowed to send only one (1) Elementary Teacher and one (1) Learner.
3. Teacher/Learner contestants will choose stories appropriate for Elementary Learners preferably a locally developed Big Books in English (for Teachers) and Filipino (for Learners).
4. Each contestant is given 5 to 8-minute pre-recorded video presentation to be submitted to the Division Organizer through a goggle drive to be provided in a separate memorandum. Official time of the presentation will be referred to time recorded reflected in the video and a penalty of 1point deduction in every 30 seconds in excess.
5. Content and References of the Video Presentation should adhere to the LRMS Standards ready for Quality and Assurance.
6. Points will be given based on the following criteria:

Language Proficiency	25 %
<i>(Language Use, Pronunciation, Pause, Pitch, and Pace)</i>	
On-Camera Performance	30%
<i>(Eye Contact, Gestures, Facial and Emotional Expressions)</i>	
Vocal Variety and Projection	15%
Video Technical and Visual Effects	<u>30%</u>
<i>(Background, Transition, Animation, Graphics/Illustrations)</i>

Side Notes:

The Story Teller

- a) may wear any of the characters' costume;*
- b) will include in the introduction the names of the author and illustrator;*
- c) will ask motivation and motive questions ;*
- d) may use strategies to make the flow interactive;*
- e) may exaggerate highlighted parts of the story like change the voice, may sing, dance or act;*

- f) *may use background music but should balance the volume;*
- g) *will include to mention the moral lesson/values integrated in the story; and*
- h) *summarize the story in the end by giving another concluding statement.*

GUIDELINES / MECHANICS FOR STORY RETELLING
Secondary School Teacher- English

1. Only one (1) Secondary Teacher shall represent each district.
2. Teacher-Contestants shall wear the official DepEd Uniform with ID.
3. All Teacher-Contestants shall be placed in a holding room for an hour to read the story to be provided by the organizer.
4. The Teacher-Contestants will be called one by one to the contest venue to retell the story minus the copy of the story or any picture or aid.
5. The Teacher-Contestants is given 5-7 minutes to retell the story. A warning sign will be given after his/her six (6) minutes presentation and will be stopped even if he/she is not still done retelling the story after 7 minutes.
6. The points will be given based on the following criteria:

Accuracy	25%
Vocal Variety	20%
On-Stage Performance.....	30%
(Eye Contact, Gestures, Facial and Emotional Expressions)	
English Proficiency	<u>25%</u>
(Language Use, Pronunciation, Pause, Pitch and Pace)

GUIDELINES / MECHANICS FOR STORY BOOK READING
Elementary/Secondary School Heads- English

1. Only one (1) contestant who is a school head shall represent each district.
2. School Head-Contestants shall wear an IP Costume (in honor to our venue).
3. All contestants shall be placed in one room as a holding area to read the Big Book for an hour provided by the organizer.

4. The contestants are given 5-7 minutes each to READ the STORY using the Big Book provided. A warning sign will be given after his/her six (6) minutes presentation and will be stopped even if he/she is not still done reading the story after 7 minutes.

5. The points will be given based on the following criteria:

Voice Projection	20%
Vocal Variety	20%
On-Stage Performance.....	30%
(Eye Contact, Gestures, Facial and Emotional Expressions)	
English Proficiency	<u>30%</u>
(Language Use, Pronunciation, Pause, Pitch and Pace)
