
"DAYGON" COMPETITION

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office X, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will hold a **Regional Virtual Christmas "Daygon" Competition** in December 9-10, 2021.
- 2. The objectives of the competition are following:
 - a. Showcase the talents of the teachers despite the present challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
 - b. Provide teachers with the opportunities for cultural and aesthetic experiences through active participation in music;
 - c. Enhance their understanding and appreciation of the arts; and
 - d. Promote empowerment through musical excellence by forging friendship among the participants.
- 3. The contest is open to all public school choral groups composed of teaching personnel of the 14 divisions of the Region. There shall be only one entry per division. The choral group shall be composed only of 10-12 members who may be all male, all female, or combination. Attached to this Memorandum are the contest mechanics and guidelines for your reference.

REGIONAL VIRTUAL CHRISTMAS "DAYGON" COMPETITION

The COVID-19 virus has affected everyone anywhere in the world. It has brought changes to daily practices and even put a stop to some activities at home, the workplace, and the community. The Department of Education (DepEd) is not excused in the catastrophe that this Pandemic has caused. Yet, DepEd explored all possibilities to continuously perform its mandate. Also, DepEd provides teachers and all its employees with necessary support to lessen the impact of the pandemic in their lives.

DepEd Regional Office X believes that music is a source of hope, especially in these most trying times. The Office wants to provide sanity break and wellness to its employees. Hence, other than the Holiday season to celebrate, the Office will conduct a Virtual Christmas Daygon Competition. This activity is aimed at building reconnection and celebrating the vuletide season without breaking the minimum health standards and providing motivation and encouragement to its employees.

I. OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Showcase the talents of the teachers despite the present challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- 2. Provide teachers with the opportunities for cultural and aesthetic experiences through active participation in music;
- 3. Enhance their understanding and appreciation of the arts; and
- 4. Promote empowerment through musical excellence by forging friendship among the participants.

II. PARTICIPANTS

- 1. The contest is open to all public school choral groups composed of teaching personnel of the 14 divisions of the Region. There shall be only one entry per division.
- 2. The choral group shall be composed only of 10-12 members who may be all male, all female, or combination.

III. MECHANICS

- 1. The divisional entry shall sing one English classical Christmas carol and one Filipino Christmas medley carol (Tagalog or Cebuano songs) in SATB arrangement.
- Using a minus one or live music accompaniment, the participants must sing and videotape a performance. The recorded performance must be

on a single video of up to 7 minutes, including introduction, if any. A penalty of two points per minute shall be deducted from the final tabulated score for any undertime or overtime.

- 3. The recording must be in .mov, .mp4, or .avi format, be clear in both image and sound, made without disturbances, background noise, etc. The device must be positioned such that the performers, gestures etc. are visible.
- 4. The video entries of the divisions shall be uploaded via this link: https://bit.ly/2Wlviqq on or before December 1, 2021. The actual judging of the competition is on December 3 while streaming of the performances is on December 9-10 during the 2021 Pasidungog sa Aminahanang Mindanao.
- 5. The participants must wear appropriate attire during their recorded performance. Choreography or movements (e.g., hand claps, foot stomps, body percussion, etc.) are permitted. Human props are discouraged.
- 6. The contest, including the announcement of winners, will be conducted online via Facebook Page at Department of Education Region 10.
- 7. Drawing of lots shall be made to determine the sequence of the performance among participants a week before the actual day of the contest. A separate Memorandum shall be issued for the schedule of the showdown.
- 8. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
