TOP THREE WINNERS IN THE REGIONAL SEARCH FOR 2021 SAFE CI

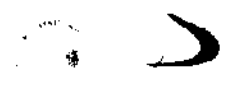


