1. The DepEd Football Referees Association (DEFRA) and Pilipinas Futsal Eskwela Association (PFEA), in coordination with the Palarong Pambansa Board, will conduct the **Allianz Virtual Football and Futsal Ball Mastery Challenge**, which shall be staged in four clustered eliminations (North Luzon Leg, South Luzon Leg, Visayas Leg, and Mindanao Leg) and one National Finals Competition. 2. 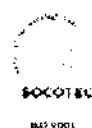

Allianz Virtual Football and Futsal Ball Mastery Challenge Proposal

I. Title

Allianz Virtual Football and Futsal Ball Mastery Challenge

In partnership with The Allianz, Department of Education – Palarong Pambansa Secretariat, DEPED Football Referees Association (DEFRA) and Pilipinas Futsal Eskwela Associations (PFEA).
(Football and Futsal Palarong Pambansa Continuity Plan. Online and NO REGISTRATION FEE)

II. Objectives

The specific objectives of this competition are to:

1. encourage students to join skill competition via online platform,
2. regain athletes' enthusiasm in football and futsal amidst the pandemic,
3. prepare public and private schools Athletes and Coaches for future face to face tournament.

BALL MASTERY:

Ball mastery is **the demonstrated ability to manipulate the ball comfortably using the following contact surfaces of both feet:** (Sole of the foot. ·Inside of the foot. ·Outside of the foot. ·Instep of the foot).

- Players are encouraged to take more touches of the ball.
- Manipulate it with the different parts of their feet.

SOME EXAMPLES OF BALL MASTERY

- Ball Tapping, Pull - Push, Sole Roll, V-shape Pull - Push, Double scissor, step across, scissor and push, double scissor, step over, flip flap, drag stop/laces/fakepass, drag stop/fake pass. Fake pass, drag stop/laces, drag stop/double scissor, drag stop/scissor, drag stop/step over, triple sole drag, drag stop, double tap, inside/outside (both feet), different rhythm, inside/outside, The V, The V opposite, Sole drag/Step over, Tip tap toe/step over, Pull Push, Sole drag, advanced sole drag, sole taps,

III. Rationale

In this time of pandemic and vaccines are already available, there is a huge possibility that face-to-face tournament will return. This virtual football and futsal skills competition will be conducted to improve and develop the talents and skills of each football and futsal athletes across the country. The Department of Education through Palarong Pambansa Secretariat, Football and Futsal Sports Manager and Stakeholder -The Moran Foundation, Inc. and Allianz fully understand the need to conduct this activity to bring learning and passion to the heart of every student athlete.

V. MONITORING AND EVALUATION

To ensure the effective and efficient conduct of this competition.

1. Only one group will serve as TWG.
2. Monitoring and Observation by the Team from Palarong Pambansa Secretariat and by the Football and Futsal Sports Manager must be done.

VI. COMPETITION GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

- a. Video entry must be shot horizontally (Landscape mode) and must be clearly cover the totality of the performance (performer's movements, routine, etc.)
- b. Performances should be **30 seconds** recorded video during Elimination Round (clustered regions), and **1-minute** recorded video during National Finals.
- c. Performances shall be accompanied by any genre of music or any musical instrument of choice as background as long as copyright rules on music/audio are strictly followed.
- d. Performance must be done and filmed at the venue of their choice within the vicinity area of their **house, backyard** and **not in public place**.
- e. Camera to be used in filming the performance must be steady. Participants are encouraged to use a **tripod** to make the camera stable.
- f. Video recording must have done from the beginning up to the end of performance via **Tiktok** platform.
- g. Submission of recorded video entry shall be uploaded, on or before February 24, 2022.
- h. No other individuals, except the performer, shall be seen in the video recording.
- i. No unnecessary or extraneous noises, comments and effects must be heard from the video except from the audio that is necessary in the performance.
- j. Submitted video entry must be continuous and should **NOT be edited** (no splicing, stitching, and application of visual effects).
- k. Use of appropriate virtual background is created by participants which does NOT show violence, sexual and other similar themes.
- l. Appropriate sports (football / futsal) attire is a must.
- m. Video resolution of submitted entry must be 1080p (high definition or higher if possible).
- n. The decision of judges is FINAL and cannot be contested.
