**Subject: SKILLS MAPPING AND PROFILING OF POTENTIAL DIVISION
STORYBOOK WRITERS**

Date: March 2, 2022

1. In line with the Implementing Rules and Guidelines of Republic Act 10533, the Basic Education Act of 2013, specifically Rule II Curriculum Section 10, 10.3 re: Production and Development of Materials, the Learning Resources Management Section under Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct Skills Mapping and Profiling of Potential Division Pool of Storybook Writers on March 2-23, 2022.
2. To ensure that the Division can provide beautiful children's stories to the learners, this activity aims to: (a) screen potential storybook writers, (b) identify potential storybook writers, and (c) enhance the storybook writing skills of teachers.
3. The potential storybook writers shall meet the following qualifications:
 - a. must be a bona fide elementary or secondary school teacher;
 - b. must possess skills in writing Filipino children's stories and can be able to translate these into English version or vice versa;
 - c. must be willing to accomplish the task given within the timeline; and
 - d. preferably, must have experience in writing children's stories. However, if there is no experience yet, qualifications a-c must be met.



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4. Teachers willing to belong to the pool of storybook writers may register and submit their original manuscript of Filipino children's stories with English translation through this link <https://bit.ly/35CjKp4> on or before March 23, 2022.
5. The 120 storybook writers (30 writers for each level from Kindergarten to Grade 3) shall be selected through the original story manuscript they will be submitting via the link given above. To avoid plagiarism or copyright infringement, the teachers are discouraged from copying or rephrasing stories from other sources.
6. The screened 120 storybook writers shall be the training participants whose names will be mentioned in a separate memorandum to be posted later.
