SUBJECT: **GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM FOR FY 2022**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2022 dated March 11, 2022 re: Supplemental Guidelines on DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2021 (Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program), this Office hereby informs the field of the list of SBFP recipient schools with its corresponding number of beneficiaries and budget allocation. The procurement of Nutritious Food Products (Enhance Nutri-bun) shall be through clustered schools with the identified Lead Schools serving as the procuring entities but deliveries can be made directly to the recipient schools. Meanwhile, the procurement for the Milk Component will still be through alternative modes of procurement - Agency to agency and deliveries will be made through the identified drop-off points (please see Enclosure No. 1).
2. All 68 Elementary School Heads are directed to submit the SBFP supporting documents in duplicate copies, to wit:
 - a. Letter Request for Cash Advance
 - b. SBFP Forms 1, 2, and 5
 - c. Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP)
 - d. Work and Financial Plan (WFP)
 - e. Annual Procurement Plan (APP)
 - f. SBFP Cycle Menu
3. Submission of the SBFP supporting documents shall be in **hard copies** to School Health Section attention: **PAUL REGIE C. MABELIN, Medical Officer III** and in **soft copies** thru this e-mail: schoolhealthsection@gmail.com, on or before **May 19, 2022**. The afore-mentioned forms are available for downloading at our website: www.depedmalaybalay.net.
4. Moreover, the beneficiaries for the SBFP - Nutritious Food Products FY 2022 with a total of 30 feeding days and SBFP - Milk Component FY 2022 for 16 feeding days will still be the same learners identified to be the recipients for SBFP for SY 2021-2022.
5. Widest dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
