MALAYBALAY CITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

MALAYBALAY CITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

1. He/She should be a son/daughter of parents who are actually residing in the City of Malaybalay (A certification from the barangay that they are residents).
2. He/She must be a senior high school graduate whose average is 83% or higher with no grade below 80 per subject in grade 12.
3. He/She must not enjoy any scholarship grant from the school or any sponsoring group.
4. He/She must take and pass the qualifying competitive examination conducted by the City Government.
5. He/She must pass the entrance examination of the State College or any School/College and enroll in any school within Bukidnon.
6. He/She must be not more than 21 years of age at the time of his/her application.
7. He/She must be of good moral character. (A certificate of good moral character signed by the Senior High School Principal).
8. He/She must be financially incapable to pursue a college education whose parents annual NET income does not exceed to P150, 000.00.
9. Limited to one beneficiary per family.
10. To maintain his/her scholarship, he/she must have a grade of not less than 2.75 for regular scholar and 3.0 for Indigenous People (IP) as final grade of the semester in any of subjects taken.
11. A scholar who make it to the dean's list will receive an incentive of Php 2,000.00 as recognition to the scholastic performance per semester.
12. This year, 200 regular scholars and 50 I.P's (Indigenous People) could avail of the program
13. Shifting of the course may be allowed after getting approval from the registrar

MALAYBALAY CITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

1. Birth Certificate.
2. Income Tax Return of parents does not exceed to Php 150,000.00 annual net income or BIR certificate of tax exemption.
3. Grade 12 report card (No grade below 80 in all subjects and with an average of 83%).
4. Certificate from the Punong Barangay that he/she is a resident of the Barangay (Barangay Clearance).
5. Good Moral Character Certificate.
6. I.P. certification from the tribal council in the barangay that he/she is a member of any known recognized tribe of Bukidnon (at least 25% blood), noted by the barangay captain.
7. One (1) piece 2x2 ID picture.
8. Certificate of Registration/Study Load for current semester.
9. Statement of Account for current semester.
