**Subject: SKILLS MAPPING AND PROFILING OF DIVISION POOL OF  
 STORYBOOK WRITERS FOR GRADES 4-6 AND SKILLS MAPPING AND  
 PROFILING OF DIVISION POOL OF ILLUSTRATORS (BATCH 2)**

1. In preparation for the coming 4<sup>th</sup> National Storybook Writing Competition, which shall commence in July 2022, the Learning Resource Management section under the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct Skills Mapping and Profiling of Division Pool of Storybook Writers for Grades 4-6 and Skills Mapping and Profiling of Division Pool of Illustrators (Batch 2) on June 8-17, 2022.

2. The potential writers and illustrators shall register at the link listed below:

3. The potential **Grades 4-6 storybook writers** shall meet the following qualifications:

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- a. must be a bona fide elementary or secondary school teacher in the Division;
  - b. must have attended the training-workshop on storybook writing conducted on May 18-20, 2022, and May 25-27, 2022. However, those interested teachers without any training in storybook writing may join, but they are required to attach a google drive link (shareable to anyone) for the sample of an original storybook manuscript in the registration link;
  - c. must be willing to accomplish the task given within the timeline and render service beyond official time; and
  - d. preferably, must have experience in writing children's stories.
4. In addition to the pool of Division Illustrators (batch 1), the Division needs more potential **Illustrators (batch 2)** with the following qualifications:
- a. must be a bona fide elementary or secondary school teacher or non-teaching personnel in the Division;
  - b. must be a visual artist or knows how to illustrate using different media. Knowledge of digital art is an edge but not a requirement. He/she shall attach a google drive link (shareable to anyone) for the sample of original artwork in the registration link; and
  - c. must be willing to render service beyond the official time and willing to accomplish the task within the timeline.
5. Further, there is no required number of writers and illustrators who will intend to register.
6. Teacher-writers and illustrators shall be granted five to ten days of service credits in July 2022. Cash awards up to ₱50,000.00 shall be given to the National winners (both writers and illustrators). A separate Memorandum will be posted for the Orientation on the Guidelines and Mechanics to be sent by the Central Office-Bureau of Learning Resources.
