The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns-Youth Formation Division (OASYASC-YFD), in partnership with Microsoft Philippines, will conduct a series of **Microsoft Youth Ambassadors (MYA) Initiatives** through a **Capstone Program** on any available days from **1-25 June 2022** via **Microsoft Teams**.

The MYA program was launched last 30 November 2021, and it aims to shape empowered Filipino students who employ globally competitive skills and embody the ideals of being value-driven, career-oriented, culturally rooted and socially responsible. It also aims to onboard qualified students to serve as the DepEd ambassadors who will champion the innovative use of technology to their classmates and peers.

MYA-related publication materials shall be shared to division youth formation social media sites. 3. Through the Youth Formation Coordinators (YFCs), the Division Office shall provide assistance to the MYAs in the identification of schools to be invited to participate in the Capstone Program and shall notify the school head regarding the engagement.
School	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the school is invited to participate, the School Head, through the SSG teacher-adviser, shall ensure maximum participation of all students from Grades 7 to 12 to participate in the said program. 2. The ICT coordinator of the school shall provide technical support to the MYAs and to all students who wish to participate. 3. MYA-related publication materials shall be shared to the social media sites of the school.
