DEPED COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM (DCP)

The Office of the Undersecretary of Administration (OUA) through the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS), in partnership with Microsoft Philippines, will work with all concerned to **standardize Operating Systems across all DCP devices deployed in the field**.
